PET POLICY VILLAGES OF WOODRIDGE

To promote community safety and ensure consistency with our pet policy, the Villages of Woodridge HOA has adopted a new rule regarding dog ownership within the community.

Effective July 1, 2026, dogs weighing more than 50 pounds (fully grown) are not permitted

Residents must provide current veterinary documentation for all dogs residing in the household, including:

- The dog's name, breed, and age
- Proof of vaccinations and spay/neuter status
- The most recent recorded weight from a licensed veterinarian
- Name and phone number for the veterinarian

The HOA reserves the right to verify information provided by contacting the listed veterinarian. Any falsification or failure to provide updated information upon request may result in violation notices and applicable fines under HOA policy.

Homeowners who currently have dogs weighing more than 50 pounds will not be required to re-home their pets.

This policy will apply only to dogs acquired after November 1, 2025.

To ensure proper documentation, all dog owners provide the required information about your dog to Linda Stanko no later than June 1, 2026, so your pet can be registered as residing in your household prior to the policy change taking effect.

Non-compliance fine: \$100.00 every 30 days past deadline.
